

Founded following the 2004 Boxing Day Tsunami, Hands Across the Water cares for children in Thailand who are either abandoned, have lost their parents or are in a similar at-risk situation. Hands operates across seven locations and provides food, education and a loving home to more than 350 children, while supporting a further 40+ through university. 100% of all donations go directly to the kids; Hands Group - a social enterprise that sits next to the charity - generates income to fund the administration and marketing costs of the charity.
