

INSTRUCTIONS

Below are some sample letters/email and social media post copy for you to use to get started.

We encourage you to personalise the messages below based on your own reasons for joining the ride and relationship to Hands Across the Water [Hands].

REMEMBER: Don't be afraid to ask. As many past fundraisers will tell you, people **will** donate to your cause, **you just need to ask them**.

Language Preferences

It's incredibly important for us at Hands to take the time to ensure our language and choice of wording in all our communications is in line with our values and ensures the utmost respect and privacy for the kids in our homes.

As a Hands community member, we extend this responsibility to you too! We ask you to take the time to review the following guidelines when you are talking about the experience you are undertaking – whether this is verbally, in social media, written format, etc.

We do not refer to the people we support as **orphans**. They are **kids**, children, young adults, adults and communities.

We do not call where they live, **orphanages**. They are their **homes**, just like yours and I.

They are not **institutionalised**. They have been dealt immense **adversity** at a young age, of which we are helping them to overcome through shelter, security, love, education, food, medicine and a promising future.

We do not disclose or identify kids individually as having **HIV**. Instead, they have **medical needs** that require long term attention.

Letter/Email to ask

You can use this communication to ask:

- All contacts, friends, family, colleagues, neighbors, trainers, baristas, etc.
- Organisations of which you are seeking sponsorships or fundraising
- Your workplace networks
- Local businesses





Sample Letter/Email Copy (Long version):

Dear

I have some exciting news that I want to share, and I hope it will excite and inspire you as well! I have decided to participate in the **Hands Across the Water** [Ride Name] [Ride Year] Experience that will see me and a group of teammates riding [#]km in Thailand while fundraising for Hands Across the Water.

Just as important as filling their bellies with healthy food and providing a safe bed to sleep in, with the support of amazing donors like you, the vision of Hands is to help these kids see the opportunities that lie before them, to see a life of choice.
